# The Pastor's Corner

I was in 7th grade when Our Lady of Kibeho, appeared to High School students in Kibeho, a village in the south of Rwanda. Kibeho is an hour long walking distance from where I was born and raised. Every time I went home for school break. I travelled to Kibeho with my siblings and cousins. There we met tens of thousands of other pilgrims; many of whom travelled days and nights from all the corners of Rwanda and neighboring countries to listen to the messages of our Lady. Many people stayed in Kibeho for days praying and renewing their faith, sharing stories. When they returned home, their lives were changed. So was mine. Kibeho nourished my faith and my devotion to the Blessed Mother. My love for Pilgrimages was born in Kibeho.

My last pilgrimage took me to Krakow in Poland and to Medjugorje. In and around Krakow, we prayed, toured and admired the beauty of the churches where St. John Paul II was baptized and catechized, where he was a bishop and the Center "Have no Fear" where his relics are available for pilgrims.

Just outside of Krakow we visited and celebrated Mass in Lagiewniki, the capital of Divine Mercy where the message of Divine Mercy originated which Christ himself wished to pass on to our generation through Saint Faustina. In Medjugorje, whether visiting visionaries in their homes, or walking up and down the Hill of apparitions and Cross Mountain, or spending time with Jesus in evening adoration or simply meeting and talking to other pilgrims from the four corners of the globe, you always find yourself embraced with peace and grace and great healing.

When I am on a pilgrimage, I'm inspired by the natural beauty of landscapes and rich historical and cultural heritage of places I visit. Following the steps of men and women who through human struggle and divine intervention, kept their faith and are now our models as Saints - that's the beauty of pilgrimage for me.
