The Pastor's Corner

Today we celebrate a feast day – The Exaltation of the Holy Cross. It is one of the few Sundays during the year when we celebrate a feast in place of the Sunday celebration. The feast has a special meaning in the archdiocese of Boston because our Cathedral Church is dedicated to the Holy Cross.

Each week I enjoy reading the words of Pope Francis. We receive copies of his daily homilies as well as his other talks. In a recent homily Pope Francis said, “The privileged place for an encounter with Christ are our sins. If a Christian is incapable of seeing his sins and his salvation in the blood of Christ, he has only gone half way. He is a tepid Christian.” Pope Francis concluded his homily with words pertinent to today’s feast of the Holy Cross. He invited the faithful to ask themselves whether they are capable of telling the Lord that they are sinners; whether they really believe the Lord has given them new life; whether they trust in Christ. Because he said – a Christian can be boastful of two things – of his sins and of Christ on the cross.
