The reason is the conflict between the Vigil Mass on Saturday for the following Sunday and also the conflict on Sunday afterwards. But All Saints Day is still a wonderful feast day in our church. We are all familiar with the canonized saints of the church like Saint Paul, Saint Patrick, Saint Anthony and more recently Saint John XXIII and Saint John Paul II. But on All Saints Day. we also honor the saints in heaven who are not canonized saints. It is the day we recognize the men and women who have led holy lives - our moms and dads, family members and friends, people who have influenced us in our lives. It is also a celebration of hope the promise of our faith, the promise of heaven and eternal life for all of us who aspire to be saints.

St. Irene Peer Leaders Organize to Help Stamp out Hunger in Massachusetts

St. Irene's Peer Leaders are joining high school students across the commonwealth to help stamp out hunger.
