The Vicar's Corner

Lent is around the corner. This Wednesday, February 10th is Ash Wednesday. The Liturgy of the Word on Ash Wednesday gives us a glimpse on the true meaning of Lent:

"Rend you hearts, not your garments," says the Book of Joel.

"A clean heart create in me, O God, and a steadfast spirit renew with me," says Psalm 51.

"Behold, now is a very acceptable time; behold now is the day of salvation," says St. Paul to the Corinthians.

"When you give alms, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your almsgiving may be secret... When you pray, go to your inner room, close the door and pray to your Father in secret... When you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, so that you may not appear to be fasting except to your Father who is in secret." Lent calls us for spiritual renewal through conversion and Penance, fasting and giving, praying and receiving God's grace.
