The Pastor's Corner

Several years ago, the Archdiocese began to put two or three parishes together as a collaborative. The parishes retain their identity but are served by one pastor. We have been informed that St. Irene Parish and Holy Family Parish in Concord will become a collaborative in June 2019. At that time both Fr. Fleming and I will be asked to resign as pastors. This will be a major change since I have been pastor here for 29 years and Fr. Fleming has been pastor in Concord for 25 years. The reason for the collaborative process is the lack of priests to serve our parishes. Our Parish Council has met with the Parish Council from Concord several times and we will continue to work together to make the process work for our parishioners in both parishes.
