Concord Prison Outreach Project

We will be collecting items for the Concord Prison Holiday Gift Bag Project from **Saturday, Nov. 10 - Sunday, Dec. 2**; please put your contributions in the box located in the church vestibule.

Donations do not have to be in sets. Adult volunteers will assemble the gift bags. Each gift bag will contain a bar of deodorant soap (4-5 oz.), toothpaste (5.8 - 6 oz.), a pad of WHITE paper (6" x 9" or 5" x 8", 100 pages, no wire), a pair of white CREW socks with no more than 5 inches of ribbing (no tube socks, knee highs or "tennis" socks), a bottle (plastic) of shampoo (12-15 oz.), a stick of deodorant 2,5 oz. or larger (no roll-ons or gels) and a hand made holiday greeting card ("Happy Holidays, Seasons Greetings, Merry Christmas, no religious cards), signed with first names only.
