### Mission Appeal ~ July 13/14

As part of annual Mission Co-Operative Program, Fr. Gabriel Muteru from the Archdiocese of Nyeri, Kenya will speak at all Masses this weekend about The Society of St. Peter Apostle, one of the Four Pontifical Mission Societies represented in the Archdiocese of Boston. Fr. Muteru will share stories about his experiences in the missions and help us build a spiritual connection to others whose daily lives may be very different from our

own. The Society of St. Peter Apostle is the official mission agency of the Catholic Church dedicated to supporting the education of seminarians and religious men and women in the missions. Every year, the Society of St. Peter Apostle funds up to half the tuition of each seminarians and novice in the missions because their diocese and families are too poor to afford tuition, room and board, and the cost of text books. May our hearts and ears be opened by the Holy Spirit to support and pray for people—especially seminarians and novices who are the future of our Church in the missions. Thank you in advance for your prayerful support.”

## Protecting God's Children / CORI Checks

All clergy, Parish staff, and volunteers who minister, work, or serve in a capacity involving contact with children under eighteen must complete the prevention and education programs mandated by the Archdiocese of Boston (Virtus/Protecting God's Children). Dates and locations for training are listed at the Archdiocese website: <http://www.bostoncatholic.org>.

The Archdiocese also requires a criminal offender record information (CORI) check for all full and part-time paid staff members, all clergy and **all volunteers (18 years and older) who minister to or have access to children, youth, elderly or the disabled**.
